**IRA** – If you're 70 1/2 years old or older, there is a way to lower the taxes you pay on IRA withdrawals. Avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$105,000 from your IRA to GCR while satisfying your required minimum distribution for the year.



**PROPERTY AND OTHER ASSETS** – Donating appreciated real estate, such as a home or a vacation or commercial property, can make a great bequest to GCR. Avoid paying capital gains tax on the real estate sale.

## Amina's Bible is her most treasured possession

"Knowing the words of God is so good," says Amina, who lives in southwestern Chad. Amina can hear those life-changing words because a donor like you gave her an audio Bible she carries everywhere.

Amina's story unfolds like a parable of resilience written in the margins of hardship. Born and raised in her village, she is one of nine children in a family where not everyone shares her Christian faith. Her journey to Jesus began when a local pastor proclaimed that Jesus is the Savior, and those who believe in Him will be saved.

"When I started my life with Jesus, everything became new," she recalls, her eyes brightening despite the weight of recent trials.

**"I do more good to people, I am happy with people, and I love people. That's what Jesus brought—something new in my life."**

That transformation would be tested in ways she never anticipated. Married young to a Muslim man, Amina found herself abandoned with an infant son when her husband left. Now she lives in her mother's compound, a single mother navigating poverty while clinging to promises that transcend her circumstances.

The audio Bible she treasures allows her to share Scripture with neighbors who, like her, cannot read. "People always need more and more audio Bibles and SD cards," she explains, "because they are joyful when they listen to the words of God, and they want to discover more about the Bible. Some of them don't know how to read, so it is a simple way for them to discover the Bible."

In Amina's village, requests for audio Bibles far exceed supply. Believers travel from distant settlements, seeking the Word of God in languages that speak to their hearts. Each device becomes a

Miriam lives in a community in northern Chad where it can be difficult to follow Jesus. But "Jesus is everything for me," she says. "He's my Savior, He's my Lord, He's everything."

Miriam grew up in a Christian home where her childhood was shaped by Scripture. But she saw her own brothers bow to pressure and choose to follow Islam. And Miriam's faith journey hasn't been without its own struggles.

At 28, Miriam remains single with three children by different fathers—choices she openly acknowledges with regret. "I made lots of mistakes in my life," she says. "So, I ask forgiveness from God and will start a new life by following His faith to know the truth."

When offered an audio Bible during a recent distribution event, Miriam's response revealed both her personal hunger for God's Word and her heart for evangelism. She saw it as a tool for reaching others, including her Muslim brothers.

"People need more and more audio because it is helpful," Miriam explains. "Some of them can read, but by listening, they discover the truth of God."

### YOUR GIFTS HAVE RESTORED CLEAN DRINKING WATER TO 13 COMMUNITIES IN SYRIA

Christian families living in northern Syria have suffered through persecution and the violence of a prolonged civil war. When the water supply in one of the communities was disrupted in the fighting, **GCR donors helped restore access to drinking water for about 200 families.**

As a result, families no longer must depend on expensive bottled waters or drink the dirty water from a shallow well that made waterborne disease common in these communities.



## NOTES FROM THE FIELD

### Responding to the hunger for God's Word around the world

According to our Bible distribution partners, nearly half of the world's population lacks access to Scripture in their own language. As the church grows globally, the need for Bibles in diverse languages and accessible formats has increased significantly.

For example, in Chad, "The only way to read the Bible was just in French, but there was no different translation in different languages," says a local pastor. "But now it is growing. It is changing a little bit, and it is possible for every language, every person to listen to the words of God in different languages."

GCR works with partners all over the world to provide audio Bibles, SD cards, and physical copies of God's word to the persecuted church. Through our partners, we support Bible distribution in Chad, Iraq, Iran, DRC, Nigeria, Afghanistan, Pakistan, India, Mexico, Nepal, Sudan, Burkina Faso, Indonesia, China, and Mali. These projects include distribution of physical and audio Bibles, SD cards, and for some, pastoral training.

**Your partnership is vital to strengthen and empower the church in these nations by providing access to Scripture, so they may grow strong in their faith to withstand persecution.**
